



REGARDING C.R. ENGLAND AND C-TPAT

C.R. England Global Transportation (CRE) was one of the first carriers in North America to receive C-TPAT certification in September 2003. When it was decided at CRE in 2008 that we would close our Canadian operations, U.S. Customs and Border Protection advised that this would prevent CRE from maintaining an active C-TPAT certification. In March 2008, CRE's C-TPAT certification was suspended per our advice to U.S. Customs of this change.

However, CRE's dedication and compliance with the norms and standards of C-TPAT continues to be robust and includes strict seal control, conveyance chain-of-custody, independent satellite GPS monitoring of tractors and trailers, strict vetting of Mexican carrier partners, CCTV camera monitoring of interior and exterior operations areas, and positive identification of visitors at C.R. England facilities. C.R. England works exclusively with Mexican carriers that have obtained C-TPAT certification.

We welcome and encourage inspection of our facilities, policies, and practices. We are confident that your cargo and the integrity of your supply chain can be in no better hands than with C.R. England for transportation services between the U.S. and Mexico.
